Read Romans 1:18-32

- 1. When mankind chose to suppress their knowledge about God, He turned us over to our own devices. Notice the phrase "God gave them up" (ESV) in vs: 24, 26, & 28. Discuss the sinful actions that mankind was turned over to. How prevalent are these today? How about in your life?
- 2. Verse 32 presents a sobering, even terrifying truth. Why do we want to drag others down with us in our sins?
- 3. Tony suggested that homosexuality was not the worst sin Paul could think of, He mentions it because it is the reversal of God original intent in Genesis. Read Genesis 1:26-28 and 2:21-25 and discuss how God intended marriage, sexual intimacy, and children as a package deal. Discuss how we have separated them to our peril.
- 4. Discuss the reality of sexual temptation in our world today, including same sex attraction. Our modern wisdom (or lack thereof) has taught us to make our sexual orientation our primary identity. Discuss the downside of this trend.
