Digging Deeper into Romans 7:13-8:4

Read Romans 7:7-25

1. Some Bible expositors see Romans 7:14-15 as a description of the Christians normal experience, one of failure and slavery to sin. But this is the opposite of what Paul taught in Romans 6 (Read 6:11-12, 14, 18, & 22).

- Does chapter 6 or 7 describe your normal experience?
- Tony Suggested that Romans 7 is Paul's description of a person under the Law, not the normal experience of the Christian who is alive in Christ. What do you say?

Read Romans 8:1-4

2. Discuss the ramifications for daily life to know that you will never be condemned for your sin.
3. What does it mean that Jesus came in the "likeness of sinful flesh." Wasn't Jesus sinless?
4. What does it mean that the "righteous requirement of the law was fulfilled in us?" How exactly did this happen? What does it mean for our daily walk with Christ in this world?
