Last week, we learned from Romans 8:1 that because we have trusted in Christ, we will never be condemned for our sin. Then the conclusion of Romans 8 confirms this truth by telling us that nothing can remove us from the Love of Jesus. These truths bookend the rest of the teaching of Romans 8.

Reads Romans 8:1-13

- 1. Being secure in our salvation doesn't exclude our personal responsibility to live a life of obedience. The beauty of the Gospel includes that fact that the Spirit enables us to obey now.
 - → Read Ezekiel 36:25-27 and discuss the benefits of the New Covenant.
 - → Do you truly believe that you can obey God's commands now?
 - → If you answered yes, how are you doing at that?
 - → Discuss what Paul means in 8:13 by "put to death the deeds of the body." How do we do that?
- 2. Let's discuss a little theology. Read Romans 8:9-11. What can we learn about the nature of the Trinity from these verses?
